



### The Lodge

We have some GOOD NEWS! Two separate groups within our community recently obtained funding to improve our facilities.

Squirrels have been successful in obtaining a significant amount of funding which has enabled the following improvements to be made to the lodge building:

- New windows,
- New toilet with disabled access,
- Connecting door
- Redecoration, inside & outside,
- French doors (Squirrels building).

In addition the young people of the park have also obtained funding which will result in additional resources.

I am confident that you will all be impressed with these much needed improvements to this multi-purpose building which will benefit the whole community.

Over the next few weeks we will be reviewing the ongoing usage of the lodge in relation to community groups.

### Extensions to property

This is a reminder to anyone who is intending to extend their property. You need both written permission from the Trustees and Planning Permission from the local council (Cheshire West and Chester). The latter is because on the granting of planning permission for Delamere Park, the Permitted Development Rights, which usually allow you to extend your property up to certain limits, were removed. This was to help protect the special character of the Park and development on it. Your planning application will be considered on its merits by the local council.

### Tree Policy

Following the tree pruning and felling programme that was carried out earlier in the year, the Trustees have decided to undertake a full review of the Tree Policy on the Park. This is to ensure that we continue to protect and improve our very special environment and give clarity to all about what trees will be felled, pruned or planted over future years. The policy will also set out the approach that will be taken where there are issues of loss of amenity to residents or possible damage to property. To help the Trustees establish a robust policy they would welcome views and input from any interested resident or property owner. It is anticipated that discussions will take place in early June and if anyone wants to get involved, please give your name to Reception.

## Play Area

Over the last 12 months a small number of volunteers, in conjunction with the Trustees, have been exploring funding and possible equipment, which would enable the refurbishment and development of the Delamere Park Playground Facility.

At the last Trustees meeting, the Volunteers presented to the Trustees a phased proposal that would initially restore and repair some of the existing equipment. The proposal also outlined additional equipment that would enhance the experience of the children who live on the park and their guests.

This equipment was totally in harmony with the surroundings of Delamere Park and was of a Timber construction. The funding raised to facilitate these phases has been raised from a number of sources and has been given unconditionally. The plan of the Play area will be on the Clubhouse notice board and the proposal is available for more detail if required.



The Trustees have given agreement to moving this proposed project forward, using the phased approach, a time frame will be developed over the next couple of weeks looking at obtaining the required elements ready for implementation of the initial Phases.

Should you have any questions regarding the Play Builder Project, a Trustee will be available at the Clubhouse on Saturday June 12 between 11:00 and 12:00.

In the meantime fundraising will continue, with your help, to make the play area facility an area to be proud of on Delamere Park and to give to children the enjoyable experience they deserve.

Both the Volunteers and the Trustees would like to take the opportunity to thank all those people who have donated money, organised fund raising events and helped in any way. We are still looking for any assistance that may be offered in respect of actual hands on help, either refurbishing or repairing some of the existing equipment. (Please leave your contact details at the Clubhouse Reception desk if you wish to help)

We would also like to make a special mention and thank you, to a group of children (see below) who without any prompting from adults organised a sponsored run in aid of the Play builder Project. This run raised the amazing amount of £153.00 towards the play facility.
