

CORONAVIRUS: THE CLUBHOUSE, EVENTS AND ACTIVITIES

Dear Plot Owner,

As you know Coronavirus has been declared a pandemic by the World Health Organisation (WHO).

The UK appears to be in the early stages of the Coronavirus outbreak however the Trustees are conscious, given the demographic profile of Delamere Park residents that consideration has to be given to how the use of the clubhouse and facilities within it could impact on the likely spread of the virus within our close knit community. The Trustees have decided that the Tuesday night Plot Draw will be suspended until further notice and that after next Thursday's film night the clubhouse, until further notice will not be available for any organised gathering or event e.g. the coffee morning or fitness type classes. Cancellation of any events being run in the clubhouse between now and next Thursday is at the discretion of individual event organisers.

NB Plot Owners can continue to use the clubhouse and its facilities.

May we request that any resident who has returned from a potentially high risk Coronavirus area, in the UK or abroad self isolates themselves from the clubhouse and any DPML approved activities for at least two weeks after they have returned. Your help in this matter is greatly appreciated.

It goes without saying that events appear to be moving rapidly and the Trustees will be keeping a watching brief on government decrees and other related matters in respect of the running of the clubhouse and use of its facilities.
