



## Tennis Court Update

Following the latest government advice, we will be allowing limited access to the tennis courts for residents only starting from Wednesday 13<sup>th</sup> May.

In order to support social distancing and Covid -19 safety measures the following rules have been implemented and must be followed at all times:

- Access to the courts will only be permitted during daylight hours.
- Singles and doubles matches can take place with members of your own household but only on one court at a time.
- Singles matches with one other person from outside of your household can take place in line with government guidelines, but only on one court at a time.
- If playing with a none-household member please ensure you stay 2 meters apart at all times, and do not share equipment.
- The courts will be locked by a combination padlock to restrict entry. To gain entry please call the number on the padlock sign and you will be provided with the access number.
- There will be no booking service for the courts. Play will be determined on a first come first served basis. For this reason, we ask that if you are playing and another resident arrives wishing to play that you agree to conclude your game within 1 hour.
- Please provide your own hand sanitiser for use after handling the door and lock to the courts.
- The courts must be locked when you leave.
- **The Playground is still off limits to all in line with current government guidelines.**
- Only tennis is to be played on the tennis courts, no other ball games are allowed.

Other than the above stipulations there are no time limits to your allowed use of the tennis courts

**Please note that the clubhouse remains closed so there will be no access to toilets, changing rooms or refreshments.**
